Speaker Biographies

Stephen J. Birchard DVM, MS, DACVS

Dr. Birchard is a Diplomate of the American College of Veterinary Surgeons. After 27 years teaching small animal surgery at Ohio State's College of Veterinary Medicine, he is now a staff surgeon in a private specialty practice, and continues to provide continuing education to practicing veterinarians and technicians. He has written numerous book chapters and articles for refereed veterinary journals, and has conducted many clinical research studies. He is the chief editor of the Saunders Manual



of Small Animal Practice (co-edited by Dr. Robert Sherding), a comprehensive clinical reference book covering all important medical and surgical diseases seen by small animal veterinarians. He is also the former Associate Editor for Veterinary Surgery, the journal of the American College of Veterinary Surgeons.

Jennifer Brandt, PhD, MSW



Dr. Jennifer Brandt is leading the effort to provide veterinary professionals with the communication, interpersonal and teamwork skills needed to promote quality veterinary care and veterinary career success. Dr. Brandt is a nationally and internationally acclaimed guest lecturer at veterinary colleges and conferences worldwide and has served as a senior trainer and facilitator for the Bayer Institute for Health-care Communication Faculty Development Program since 2003. Dr. Brandt previously served as a medical social worker, educator and researcher specializing in work with survivors of crime and trauma and bereavement facilitation. She received her bachelor's degree in social work from the University of Indianapolis and her master's and doctoral degrees in social work from The Ohio State University.

Ashley Wiese, DVM, MS, DAVCAA

Ashley J. Wiese, DVM, MS, DACVAA is the Regional Medical Director at MedVet Cincinnati and MedVet Dayton as well as a Veterinary Anesthesia Specialist. Dr. Wiese did her internship at MedVet Columbus after graduating from veterinary school. She then returned to MedVet after completing her residency and a postdoctoral fellowship in California. She has received multiple awards for her research presented at national conferences including the American College of Veterinary Anesthesiologists (ACVA) and the Veterinary Midwest Anesthesia and Analgesia Conference. In addition to her interests in anesthetic management of clinical patients, Dr. Wiese has focused her interests on investigating and developing new and improved anesthetic techniques for elective and high risk animals requiring surgery, objective monitoring methodologies, and the clinical application of mechanism based therapies for treating pain.
